

Dear Attorney Rose,

Two business days ago, on September 28, 2017, you sent my office a number of questions addressed to Mayor Ken Cockayne as part of an investigation. Notwithstanding the extremely short turn-around time, I indicated that in a show of good faith my client would respond in writing by Monday, October 2, 2017. You indicated in previous conversations that responding by today was sufficiently timely. This is that response.

As a preliminary matter, I do need to address some of the backdrop. First, it is not clear to me from where your authority arises. You have indicated that the Council has authorized you to undertake this investigation, but it is not clear to me that the Council has the authority to hire an outside attorney for this or any other purpose. Acting in good faith, Mr. Cockayne has elected to respond nonetheless. As a matter of administrative law, however, I would appreciate clarity on the source of your authority going forward.

Second, I note three points concerning the second paragraph of your letter. I agree with the soundness of your *legal* analysis generally. That said, comporting with the timeline on a face-to-face interview was impossible if Mr. Cockayne was to have legal representation. Insisting on an interview without sufficient representation and time to prepare with counsel may be lawful, sure—but doing so lacks legitimacy. In America, we put a premium on letting people be represented by an attorney.

In addition, Mr. Cockayne strongly believes that you acted inappropriately during a previous investigation. You know this. He believes your report had factual errors and was biased. Accordingly, he doesn't trust you to be impartial. The partisan nature of the authorization exacerbates his concern.

Similarly, I do understand that you did not set the timeline here—but moving so quickly is an ambush. To move so quickly and insist on meeting someone without counsel would be neither sensible nor fair. Even so, Mr. Cockayne wishes to respond as reasonably as possible under the circumstances, thus this written exchange.

For these three reasons, although you may legally draw an adverse inference under these circumstances, doing so lacks legitimacy and fairness.

Notwithstanding these concerns, Mr. Cockayne's responses to the questions are as follows:

1. **Q:** *On what date did you receive a request from BEAT Radio to broadcast the proceedings of the City Council?*

A: March 16, 2017.

2. **Q:** *What steps did you take to authorize that broadcast? If you did not authorize it, why not?*

A: Mr. Cockayne forwarded the request to Corporation Counsel to see whether this could be done. Steve Gagne was aware of this and kept updated. All relevant emails are attached. See Attachment 1.

On June 7, 2017, Attorney Thomas Conlin, Assistant Corporation Counsel sent a memorandum asking for the matter to be put on the next Agenda. See Attachment 2. The matter was put on the June 13, 2017 Agenda. See Attachment 3. On June 13, 2017, the matter was unanimously voted on and passed. See Attachment 4. Attorneys were working with Nutmeg TV at the time to make sure all legal questions were settled and whether anything further was required.

3. **Q:** *Did the fact that BEAT Radio allowed Ellen Zupo-Sassu time on the broadcast play a role in your decision or approval of the project?*

A: No. Note that Mr. Cockayne voted in *favor* of approving the radio station and moved quickly to do so.

4. **Q:** *Why did you show Councilman David Preleski the subject photographs of Jodi Zils Gagne on or about June 13, 2017?*

A: The images concern Councilmember J. Zils Gagne's membership with her husband, Steve Gagne, to a website [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Visitors can join for free or choose to pay a membership fee. Images on the site are generally about as accessible as those on Facebook or the average dating website. In other words, the site is open to the public and so are the images.

There is nothing particularly wrong about such membership [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Membership could become a point of embarrassment. Moreover, some members of the public would make a great deal out of such membership. This could detract and distract from the work for the people of Bristol.

Mr. Cockayne was concerned that the open nature of the membership could give rise to such. Mr. Cockayne became aware of rumors [REDACTED] and that people in the community were aware of their membership to the website. Mr. Cockayne was worried the issue could be embarrassing the City as well as to Mr. Cockayne's family, being that Councilmember J. Zils Gagne is his cousin.

At that time, Mr. Cockayne believed Councilmember Preleski was a respected member of the Council. Accordingly, Mr. Cockayne elected to confide in him on this matter. They have confided in one another similarly in the past. It was Mr. Cockayne's hope that Councilmember Preleski could help put an end to people talking about it before rumors escalated.

Mr. Cockayne hoped Councilmember Preleski would treat the matter discretely. Mr. Cockayne is disappointed that the matter has been transformed into a political weapon against him.

Mr. Cockayne has no recollection of showing Councilmember Preleski the subject images on or about June 13, 2017. He does recall, however, showing such images on some other date, perhaps in May, 2017 but he is not precisely certain of when.

5. **Q:** *On that date (June 13, 2017), did you say to councilman Preleski "these are the people you are defending"? If you did not make that statement (or a statement similar in substance), what did you say to Councilman Preleski when you showed those photographs?*

A: Mr. Cockayne elaborated on his concern about embarrassment and distraction, for his family and the political process. He does not recall his exact words, but the purpose underlying his language is explained in the previous response.

6. **Q:** *How did you obtain the photographs of Councilwoman Zils Gagne?*

A: Mr. Robert Testa, a friend of Mr. Cockayne's family, shared the images about 1.5 years ago. Mr. Testa indicated he was on a website and saw the images.

7. **Q:** *On or about September 25, 2017 did you text "You and Jodi will pay" to Steve Gagne? If so, what was the purpose of the communication?*

A: Yes. As your question indicates, the quote does not make sense without context. It is a serious concern that this context was not provided to you as an investigator. Mr. Cockayne now provides that context—all relevant text messaging from that day. See Attachment 5. Mr. Cockayne provides a number of additional texts to give context to the heated nature of communications between himself and Mr. Gagne. See Attachment 6.

As the messages show, Mr. Cockayne and Mr. Gagne had an extended, testy exchange. During the exchange, Mr. Gagne seems to threaten Mr. Cockayne. Mr. Cockayne attempted to terminate the exchange and also wished Mr. Gagne to have a great afternoon.

Mr. Cockayne was informed that Mr. Gagne was texting Mr. Cockayne's mother and sister were receiving unsolicited texts from Mr. Gagne. Mr. Cockayne informed Mr. Gagne to "stop texting me. This has become harassing." The texts were such that Mr. Cockayne and his family planned on filing a criminal complaint if the texts continued.

This is why Mr. Cockayne responded as he did—he was planning on filing such a report if the harassment continued. However emotional, texting his mother and sister went beyond the bounds of decency.

The texts to Mr. Cockayne's family can be provided with sufficient notice. Mr. Cockayne has since learned that similar texts were even sent by Mr. Gagne to the ex-husband of Mr. Cockayne's fiancé and Mr. Cockayne's brother-in-law, Matthew Lamarre. See Attachment 7.

The abuses continue. Mr. Cockayne and his family along with Mr. Gagne and Councilmember J. Zils Gagne attempted to settle the matter peaceably last week. After a lengthy meeting, it was agreed that everyone would stop posting about the matter publicly and would encourage each side's supporters to stop as well. Mr. Cockayne was disappointed that the following morning, however, when sisters of Councilmember J. Zils Gagne and Steve Gagne continued, among others.


Those are the responses to the questions posed. Although I understand from where concern arises, it seems to me that the genesis is a family dispute. Mr. Cockayne's political opponents are forcing a family conflict into the political sphere.

Furthermore, Mr. Cockayne is concerned about the process of the investigation. In a previous investigation, you directed key individuals not to communicate with one another while the investigation was pending.

In the present case, Councilmembers J. Zils Gagne and D. Preleski, met with you together and behind closed doors, in executive session, providing an opportunity for them to align stories. We have since learned that Councilmember Mary Fortier is a witness. She nonetheless participated in the same executive session, and voted on the matter. The process is disconcerting ab initio.

Coupled with those concerns previously articulated, perhaps a distinct investigator, acting with the liberty to set his or her own timetable, and who is free of the potential appearances of bias identified earlier, would be more appropriate.

Hi Tom,

No misunderstanding...you are correct. The signed addendum to the agreement will allow you to give the audio feed to the Bristol Beat (my response was based on the fact that we currently don't have a signed addendum yet).

If the City receives compensation for the recording, then as stated in paragraph 7 of the agreement, "the Producer shall pay to Nutmeg Television a production fee, the amount of which shall be based on the prevailing fair market value, at commercial rates, of the production equipment and services provided by Nutmeg Television and used for the creation of the work". The reason the attorney's wrote this into the agreement is because no one, not even a nonprofit entity can make a profit or receive any compensation for works produced with public funding.

Attached, is the quote for a standard City Council Meeting for 5 hours (includes portal to portal transportation of the equipment) and crew. Let me know if you have questions or what else you might need.

Mayor, I met today with Joanie Sutter and Steve Savino from Bristol Beat Radio. In short, Nutmeg TV does not want to disrupt its relationship with Comcast Cable, which it relies upon to carry its signal, because Bristol Beat would be "stripping" the audio feed from the broadcast. While Nutmeg TV's Board may be okay with having a commercial entity using the feed for broadcast, Comcast would probably feel otherwise. Bristol Beat Radio will be amending its request to literally take our audio feed and broadcast it. I do not know if this presents any problems for our IT Department. The conditions should remain the same: no commercial sponsorship, and the program carried in its entirety. I asked Steve to get that new request into us by the end of the week so we can get it onto the June Council agenda.

No misunderstanding...you are correct. The signed addendum to the agreement will allow you to give the audio feed to the Bristol Beat (my response was based on the fact that we currently don't have a signed addendum yet).

If the City receives compensation for the recording, then as stated in paragraph 7 of the agreement, "the Producer shall pay to Nutmeg Television a production fee, the amount of which shall be based on the prevailing fair market value, at commercial rates, of the production equipment and services provided by Nutmeg Television and used for the creation of the work". The reason the attorney's wrote this into the agreement is because no one, not even a nonprofit entity can make a profit or receive any compensation for works produced with public funding.

The good news, is the enclosed short amendment to the Community Access Channel Use Agreement is all that's needed. Our corporation counsel, John Matulis felt this would suffice to allow audio distribution of the recorded Bristol City Council Meetings to the Bristol Beat Radio, LLC.

As you know, we were approached by the "Beat" as was the City for an audio feed of the meetings to be distributed on their internet station. We communicated to them that permissions were necessary from the City as it was the copyright holder.


Thank you for your inquiry to me about the commercial nature of the station. I was under my own and incorrect assumption they were a nonprofit. You are right, Tom. The Beat is prohibited from selling advertising on the meeting content and, because our Agreement is with the City this Amendment, though simple, is necessary.

The Mayor is correct that the City pays Nutmeg TV to record the meeting. But, that payment does not cover equipment or channel distribution. It pays for a 3 person crew responsible to get the equipment to your location, run the equipment, edit the meeting and provide a DVD archive copy for the City. We cannot charge for equipment or channel time on the station by law.

We have no issue working with the Beat once we have a signed document that you have given us permission to release the work to them. The Beat will need to take the audio feed in a format compatible Nutmeg TV's with no charge to Nutmeg TV and we're happy to handle those logistics with them.



When you first met with us about the potential of the feed on the Beat, you never referred to a “live” feed. We talked about Dropbox and file types with Nutmeg’s Director of Technology, Chris Bennett. All of Nutmeg TV’s discussions, agreements and amendments to those agreements with the City of Bristol refer to the release of recorded feeds. Today, when you said you wanted a “live” feed and you were planning to take it right off of the Nutmeg TV Channel on Comcast Cable it sets an entirely different set of issues into motion.

1. Nutmeg TV doesn’t have the authority to give the BB permission to take a feed (audio or video) of our channel off of Comcast Cable.
2. Nutmeg TV cannot be liable or take responsibility for the quality of the feed or lack of a feed (if Comcast has technical difficulties)

If in fact, you are requesting a “live” feed, you will need to make that request to the City who will then need to make that request to Nutmeg TV.

Thank you for your email. We have a change to the request from the Beat that may cause issues.

Steve Savino contacted me today. He mentioned they received a letter from the City and that it looked like all was “good to go” for the next meeting. I told him that until the signed amendment was returned by the City, we were unable to release any audio file.

I told Steve that once it passed, Nutmeg TV would discuss with the Beat how to best get them the audio file for retransmission. He said they wanted the live feed and were planning to take it right off the TV at their studios onto their internet station. I questioned the quality of the feed and he wasn't concerned. Now, I question the legality of that feed as it could involve Comcast Cable.

It was not our understanding that this feed would be live from the beginning, when the Beat contacted us or in our conversations with the City. The Amendment provided to you (attached) refers only to the recorded feed for retransmission.

We request that you speak with the Mayor about this change and respond back to us. We need to know what issues the City has with the Beat change and I will then need to take that information to our Board of Directors (who don't meet again until June 12th) as well as our corporation counsel, John Matulis. We don't have the authority, I don't believe, to give permission to the Beat to take a feed for transmission off of Comcast Cable, even if it is our channel, and we cannot accept any liability or responsibility for the potential poor quality of the transmission on the Beat.


Council Member Fortier stated that the City Council believed this matter regarding the Mayor was a City issue.

On motion of Council Member Fortier and seconded, it was unanimously voted: That the City Council meet with Attorney Michael Rose for advice in a future Executive Session and the City Clerk be the contact person between Attorney Rose and the City Council in scheduling this meeting.
